

BIRSTALL WAREHOUSEMAN KILLED

Private Charlie Day, Northumberland Fusiliers, son of Mrs. Day, College Street, Birstall, died on April 14th of wounds received in action. This sad news came as a great shock to his relatives in view of the fact that a letter had been received from his Lance Corporal saying that Private Day was wounded on April 14th whilst fighting in the trenches. The N.C.O. added the opinion that the wounds were not very serious, and that he would soon be well. Private Day died the following day, at the Clearing Station.

Deceased, who was 23 years of age, enlisted in December, 1914, previous to which he was employed by Messrs. Ephraim Hirst and Co. in the warehouse. He was associated with Birstall Parish Church and a member of the Church Institute.
